## WHAT IS RE-ENTRY RETREAT?

Re-Entry Retreat is a residential time of refreshment and support for cross-cultural workers in transition.

Whether you are relocating, changing roles, or have concluded cross-cultural ministry - even months or years ago - this retreat provides space to reflect, process, and prepare for what's next.

For singles, couples, young adults and families, this retreat offers worship, reflection, and conversation to help you navigate change.

Led by experienced cross-cultural workers, it's a space to be heard, encouraged, and supported by others on similar journeys.

## ADULTS

The Adult Stream focuses on transitioning well and processing the complexities of re-entry. Together and in small groups, participants explore themes such as:

- Grief and loss
- Origin and calling
- Gifts given and received
- Fears and challenges
- Vision and hope for the future

There are opportunities for worship, celebration of your service, quiet reflection, private conversations, prayer, and personal time with God.

The aim is to help you recognise how your experiences have shaped and enriched you, while equipping you with practical and spiritual tools for the next season of life.

## YOUNG ADULTS

The Young Adult Retreat is designed for tertiary-aged young adults (18+) who have completed high school and are exploring their next steps.

If you've recently returned to Australia — either independently or with your family — after living overseas, this stream offers a supportive and understanding environment. Through engaging discussions, worship, fun activities, and meaningful connection with peers, you'll have space to:

- Reflect on your cross-cultural experiences
- Celebrate your journey so far
- Build new friendships
- Gain confidence as you transition into Australian life

This program helps young adults embrace the next chapter with clarity, resilience, and hope.

## TCK CONNECT

TCK Connect is a concurrent program for children and teens, led by adult MKs/TCKs.

For many MKs/TCKs, re-entry means transitioning into an unfamiliar culture that doesn't feel like "home."

TCK Connect provides a safe, structured environment where children can:

- Share stories and memories
- Reflect on their unique experiences
- Learn from the life of Joseph
- Better understand their TCK identity
- Build friendships

The program supports children as they process change, helping them feel seen, understood, and equipped for their own transition journey.
