Product	Best for?	How to use it
Medline Heavy Duty Rollator Shop Now	Increased balance, stability, and mobility	This lightweight rollator supports a user up to 400lbs. The handgrip height is adjustable, and brakes are built into the handles for easy control.
McKesson Terries Slipper Socks Shop Now	Fall prevention	These socks come in a variety of youth and adult sizes and have multiple pairs in a pack. You want the sock to fit comfortably but snug. Extra fabric from a too-big size can reduce the effectiveness of the sock.
Drive Chrome Knurled Grab Bar Shop Now	Fall prevention	Install grab bars into wall studs or use strong drywall anchors to increase their reliability. Best placed next to the toilet, outside of the shower and inside the shower.
Dynarex Gait belt Shop Now	Fall prevention	Gait belts are worn by the care recipient and make it easier for caregivers to stabilize the recipient while helping with walking, standing or sitting.

Bedroom safety

Cardinal Wings Repositioning Underpads Shop Now	Mobility and furniture protection.	These absorbent, disposable pads can be used to lift or reposition someone up to 400lbs on a chair or bed.
M-Rail Assist Bedside Rail Shop Now	Added stability when getting into or out of bed or for sitting up in bed	The M shaped handle allows for multiple grip options, and its presence alongside the bed can help keep someone from falling out.
McKesson Alarm Sensor Pad Shop Now	Fall prevention, increased safety for those with Alzheimer's or Dementia	Place this pad under your care recipient while they're in bed or seated in a chair. The alarm will sound if they've left or fallen out of their bed or chair.
Carex Upeasy Seat Assist Shop Now	Fall prevention, mobility	If your care recipient struggles to stand up from a seated position, this assist will help propel them up. Great for post-surgery care as well.

Drive Toilet Safety Rail Shop Now	Fall prevention, mobility assistance	This safety rail mounts directly onto your toilet, no tools required. The grip bars make it easier to sit and stand from the toilet, and provide a guardrail to prevent falling off.
