What is the ASLW?

The ASLW seeks to increase the number of underrepresented ethnic minorities in the accounting profession. This invitation-only, majority expense-paid program offers ethnic minority undergraduate and graduate students an incredible experience. Over a three-day period, students will learn strategies for networking, developing a personal brand and creating a path to their dream career.

Experts from around the country offer guidance and share insights about their academic and career journeys and licensure options. ASLW attendees also have an opportunity to seek mentors and ask questions in one-to-one conversations with professionals who attend our Accounting Pipeline Diversity Symposium, which runs concurrently with the program. In prior years, participation was limited to 100 students, but we are hopeful that increased funding allows us to expand student participation.
