

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Licence No: 058/OFF/00001/2025

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012(The Act), **General Distributors Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **46 Ivory Street Rangiora** and known as **Woolworths Rangiora East**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day:
- (b) No alcohol may be sold other than—
 - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (c) Alcohol may only be sold or supplied on the following days and during the following hours when the premises are being operated as a **Supermarket**

Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm

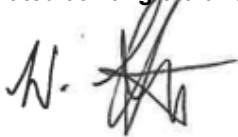
- (d) The only area delineated on the attached plan is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol:
- (e) The premises are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan received by the Waimakariri District Licensing Committee with the plan on 2 December 2024.
- (f) A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from the carpark is designated as the principal entrance.
- (g) Water must be freely available to customers on the premises during tastings.
- (h) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in their Host Responsibility Policy aimed at promoting the reasonable sale and supply of alcohol.
- (i) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.

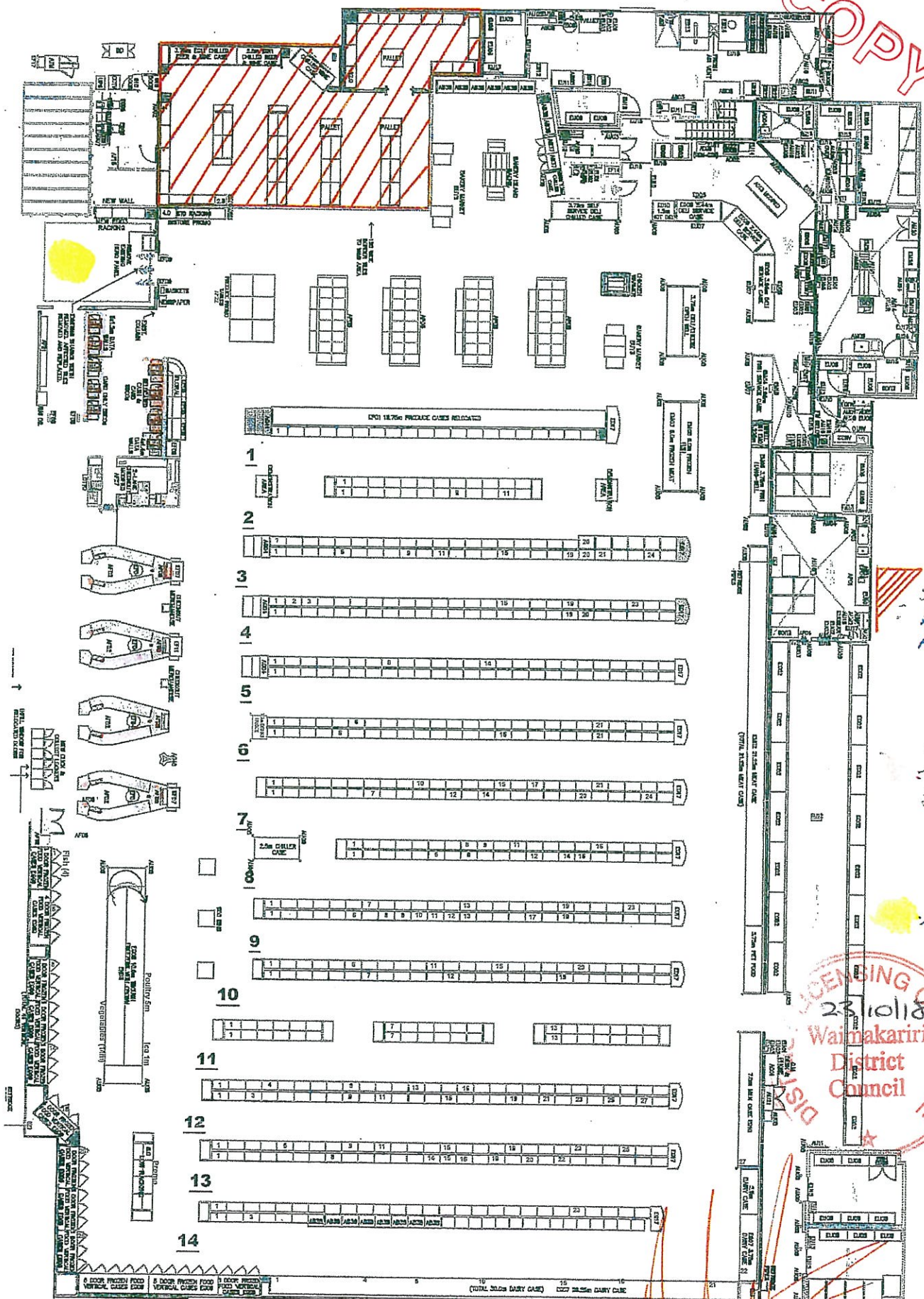
