

Notice of renewal of licence Off-licence

To General Distributors Limited - Trading as Countdown

The off-licence in respect of the premises situated at **91 Whitaker Street Te Aroha** and known as **Countdown Te Aroha** is renewed.

Conditions

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on **Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day**
- (b) No alcohol may be sold other than—
 - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the New Zealand food standard for fruit/vegetable wine; or
 - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted
- (c) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00am until 9.00pm
- (d) The whole of the premises is undesignated.
- (e) The area delineated on the attached plan (CD Te Aroha 9452 14-10-16) is the only permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol pursuant to section 112.
- (f) While alcohol is being provided free as a sample drinking water to be provided free from the same location
- (g) The holder of a Manager's Certificate or a properly appointed manager shall be on duty and on the premises at all times alcohol is sold. If a duty manager is not present then there must be no alcohol sales and a notice displayed advertising the public of this fact.
- (h) Manager's register (as required by s.232 of the Act) is to be maintained and available onsite.
- (i) The licensee must ensure the following are displayed:
 - (i) A sign to be seen from outside the principle entrance stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premise will be open for the sale of alcohol
 - (ii) A copy of the original licence with all the conditions, just inside the principal entrance so persons entering can read it.
 - (iii) A sign in a prominent place identifying the duty manager.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- a) until its expiry date detailed below; but
- b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the expiry date.
