

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012(the Act), **General Distributors Limited** is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **60 Joan Gaskell Drive Whitianga** and known as **Countdown Whitianga**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

The licence is subject to the conditions listed as follows:

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises and supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:
Monday to Sunday from 7.00am until 9.00pm
2. No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day;
3. No alcohol may be sold other than –
 - i. beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - ii. mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - iii. fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - iv. grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine;
 - v. or a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted;
4. While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons at no cost from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
5. A properly appointed Certificated, or Acting or Temporary, Manager must be on duty, at or nearby the point of sale, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - i. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - ii. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance to the premises; and
 - iii. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The "single alcohol area" for the premises is as described on the plan dated the 30 May 2024. The licensee must ensure that:
 - i. No alcohol is displayed, promoted or advertised outside the single alcohol area; and
 - ii. No products other than alcohol, low-alcohol and non-alcoholic beer, wine or mead are displayed, promoted or advertised inside the single alcohol area.
8. The single alcohol area is to be defined by a straight perimeter line drawn across the floor from the front corners of the single alcohol area. Any front-facing end of aisle alcohol racks are to be dead ended and no drop stacking of boxes of alcoholic products are to be placed at the base of the racks at the front of the single alcohol area.
9. A central pallet stack at the front of the single alcohol area (if any) must be no more than one pallet wide at the front of the display and be no more than 1.4 metres in height. Such a central pallet stack must be covered by a front dead-ended end of aisle rack. No drop stacking of boxes of alcoholic products are to be placed at the base of the central pallet stack (if any) at the front of the single alcohol area

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in or from the premises generally. The premises, situated at **60 Joan Gaskell Drive Whitianga** is more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Thames Coromandel District Licensing Committee on **30 May 2024**

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
