Sections 17 to 20 and 64
Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), **General Distributors Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **Queensgate Mall 37 Bloomfield Terrace, Lower Hutt** and known as **"Countdown Queensgate"**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) no alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day
- (b) no alcohol is to be delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11pm on any day and before 6am the following day.
- (c) a properly appointed Certificated, Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- (d) no alcohol may be sold other than—
 - i. beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - ii. mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - iii. fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - iv. grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - v. a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (e) alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm
- (f) the following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed. The licensee or manager must ensure that:
 - i. alcohol is not sold to intoxicated persons;
 - ii. statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors are observed at all times and evidence of age documents are requested where necessary;
 - iii. signs clearly stating the above requirements be placed at all points of sale.
- (g) drinking water is to be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises from inside the single alcohol area.
- (h) all requirements pursuant to Section 59 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, and Regulations 14 and 15 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 must be met when alcohol is sold by remote sale.
- (i) **the only permitted area (as delineated on the attached plan) for the display and promotion of alcohol is Aisle 1**

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - i. until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - i. until the close of the period of three years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. if it has been renewed, until the close of the period of four years after the day it was issued.

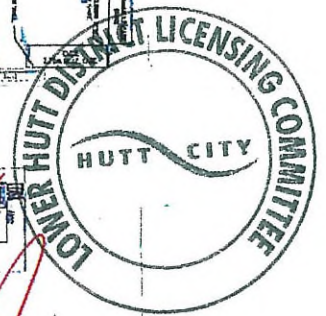
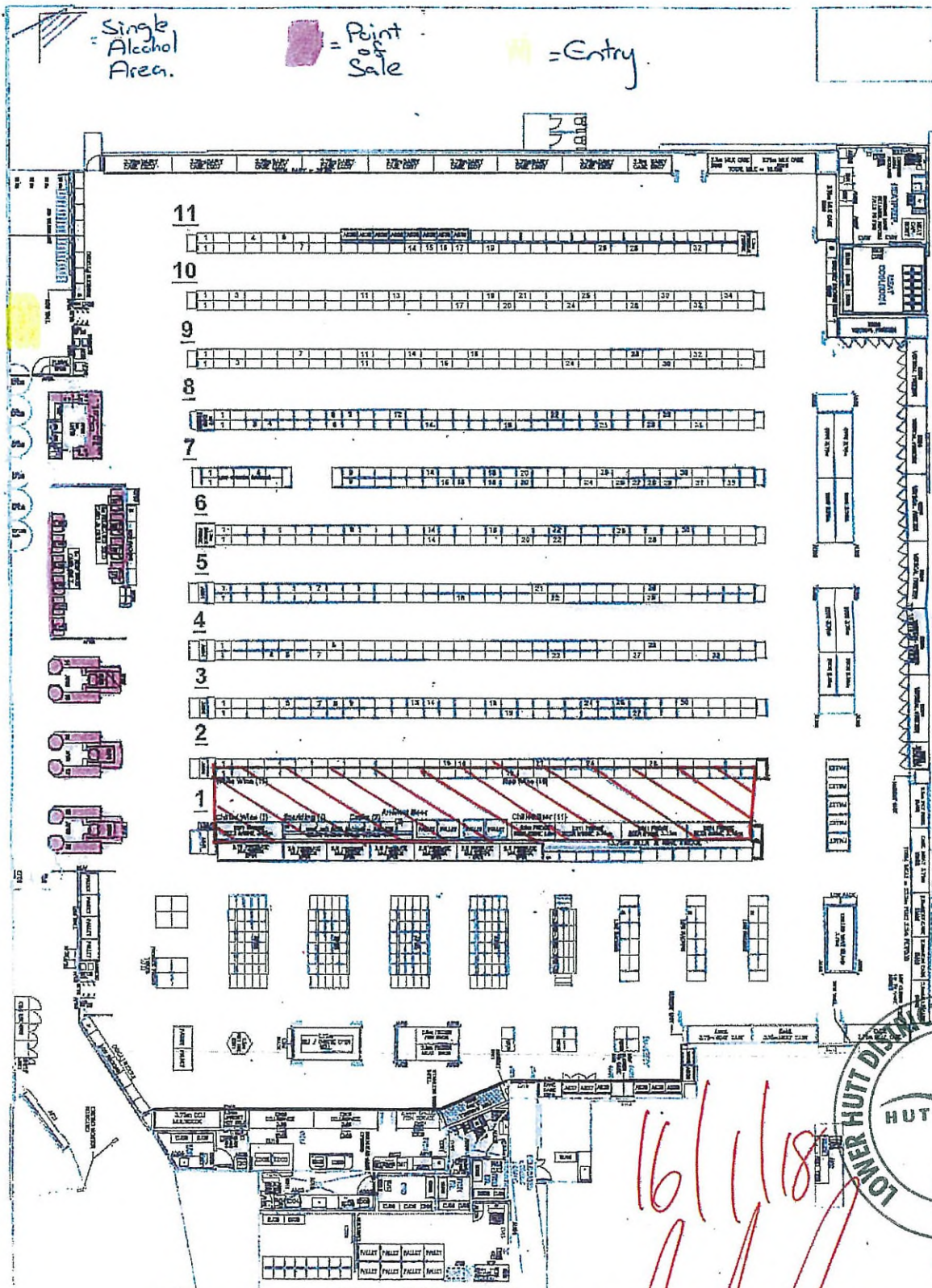
