DECISION

This is an application by **GENERAL DISTRIBUTORS LIMITED** for the renewal of an Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 109 Carnarvon Street, Gisborne, known as "**Countdown Gisborne**".

The application was duly notified and no matters in opposition to the application have been raised from any reporting agency and no objections have been lodged. Accordingly, pursuant to s.191 (2) of the Act, the matter is considered on the papers by the committee commissioner.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which the committee must have regard as set out in sections 105, 106 and 131 of the Act and I grant the applicant an off-licence renewal authorising the continued sale and supply of alcohol, for consumption off the premises.

The licence is renewed until the 3rd day of June 2025 that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry and authorise the renewal of the licence subject to the conditions attached as Appendix 1.

Appendix 1.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on ANZAC day.
2. No alcohol may be sold other than:
 - i. Beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - ii. Mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - iii. Fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - iv. Grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - v. A food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
3. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday, 7.00am to 9.00pm
4. The whole of the premises are undesignated.
5. The only area that is a permitted for the display and promotion of alcohol is delineated in the attached plan approved on 26 May 2021 and is physically bounded by a thick black line on the floor separating the alcohol area from the rest of the store.
6. Signs must be displayed at every point of sale detailing the statutory restriction on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
7. In the case of remote sales; the licensee must ensure that the requirements of section 59 of the Act are met at all times.
8. Drinking water must be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
