

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **General Distributors Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **3A Whitford Brown Avenue, Papakowhai, Porirua** and known as **Woolworths Aotea** to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol to be sold other than
 - i. Beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - ii. Mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand standard for mead; or
 - iii. Fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - iv. Grape wine that complies with the appropriate standard for grape wine; or
 - v. A food flavoring, prepared for culinary purposes that are unsuitable for drinking
- b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00 am to 10.00 pm
- c) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on Anzac Day
- d) Drinking water must be freely available and displayed whenever alcohol is being displayed by way of complimentary tastings
- e) A copy of the licence, together with a copy of the floor plan, must be placed at each principal entrance to the premises so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the entrance.
- f) The holder of a manager's certificate or a properly appointed manager shall be on duty and on the licensed premises always when alcohol is being sold
- g) The area of the premises where alcohol can be sold, supplied or consumed will be designated as 'undesigned'
- h) There will be no sale of single units of mainstream beer and cider, and mainstream beer and cider will only be sold in the form it was received in, i.e. boxes of 4,6,12,18 and 24 packs except:
 - i. where packing has become broken or damaged (unrecoverable) those items may be repacked and sold in packs of at least four
 - ii. Premium beer and cider products (e.g. premium craft) or products in a vessel measuring 330mls or greater can be sold as a single unit
- i) Signs detailing the statutory restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated people are to be displayed, and easily read from each checkout
- j) The following steps must be taken to ensure compulsory conditions of sections 112, 113 and 114 of the Act relating to the display and promotion of alcohol in the single alcohol area plan submitted with the application
 - i. Alcohol must only be sold and supplied on the premises in accordance with the premises plan submitted with the application dated 24 October 2023
 - ii. The only area delineated on the attached plan described in shading is the permitted single area for the display and promotion of alcohol
 - iii. No display or promotion of, or advertisement for a product of alcohol shall occur outside the prescribed single alcohol area of the premises.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
