OFF LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **GENERAL DISTRIBUTORS LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **105-125 COMMERCE STREET, WHAKATĀNE** and known as **COUNTDOWN WHAKATĀNE**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

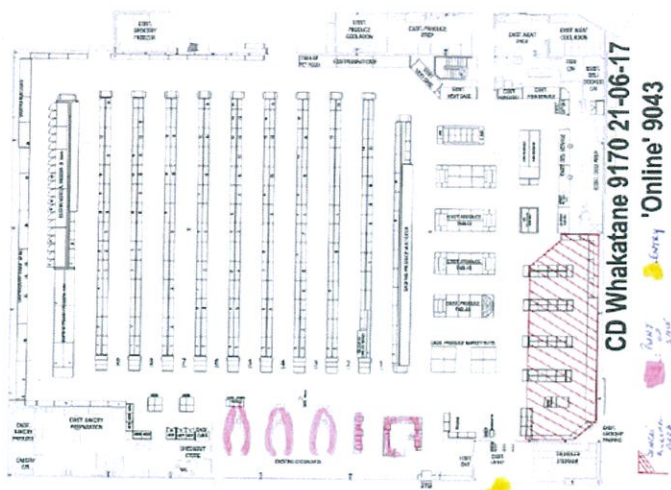
- (a) Alcohol may be sold on, or from, and delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, and supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:

0700 - 2300hrs, Monday to Sunday

- (b) No alcohol is to be sold on, or from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1:00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (c) No alcohol may be sold other than alcohol that contains no more than 15% ethanol by volume measured at 20°C and is –
- beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (d) A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty, at or near the point of sale, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- (e) While alcohol is being supplied as a free sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
- (f) The whole of the premises is designated as neither restricted or supervised, therefore is undesignated.
- (g) The 'single alcohol area' for premises is as delineated on the premises plan. The licensee must ensure that:
- No alcohol is displayed, promoted or advertised outside the single alcohol area: and
 - No products other than alcohol, low-alcohol and non-alcoholic beer, wine or mead are displayed, promoted or advertised inside the single alcohol area.
- (h) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:

- Staff must be trained in their responsibility to prevent sale of alcohol to minors or intoxicated people;
- Signage displayed at every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
- A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principle entrance to the premises; and
- A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.

PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **COMMERCE STREET, WHAKATĀNE** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- Until **5 December 2026**; or.
- If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or.
- If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.

NOTE: this licence shall expire on the same expiry date (or anniversary) as that of the licence it replaces or, if renewed, of the most recent renewal certificate.

ADVICE TO APPLICANTS

It is the licence holder's responsibility to note the expiry date for this licence and to ensure any renewal application is lodged prior to the expiry date.
