Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), General Distributors Limited (the Licensee) is authorised to sell on or from the premises situated at 121 Carters Road, Amberley, and known as Woolworths Amberley, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) No alcohol may be sold other than—
 - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (c) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday from 7.00am to 9.00pm.
- (d) The **single alcohol area** is within the alcove and chiller at the southeastern end of the premises as shown on the attached plan, dated as received by the Huronui District Licensing Committee on 14 October 2022. The licensed area is **undesignated**.
- (e) No shelf on an outward-facing end-of-aisle display, in the single alcohol area, is to be fitted at a height exceeding 1.4metres from floor level. *(For the purposes of clarity this condition refers to the height of the shelf itself and excludes the product on the shelf).*
- (f) Only the area delineated on the attached plan is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol
- (g) Drinking water must be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on:

14th day of November 2028

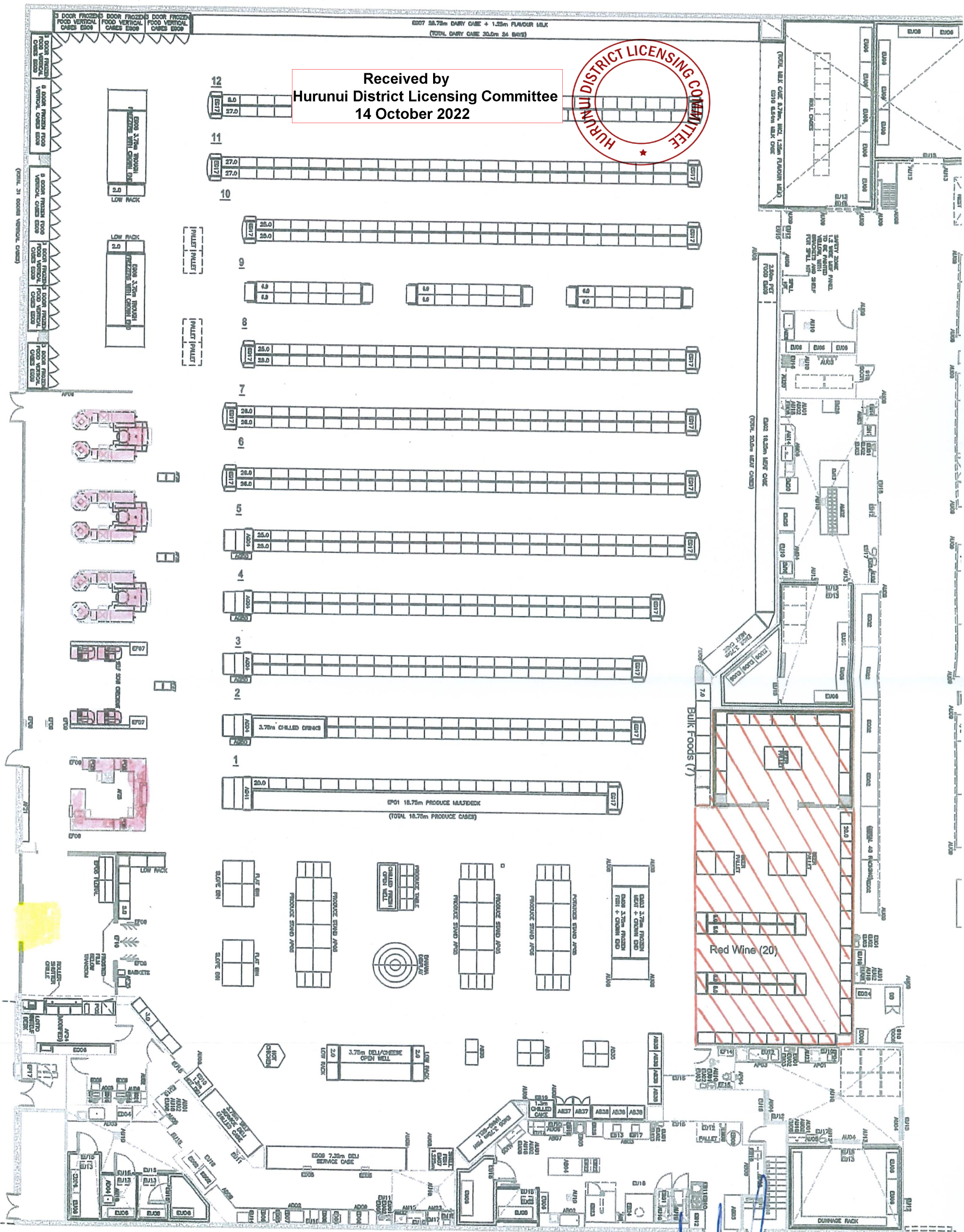
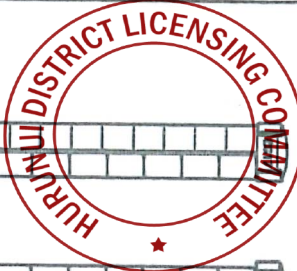
