



Off-licence

Sections 17 to 19 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

67/OFF/14/2024

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **General Distributors Limited** is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 104 Centennial Avenue, Alexandra and known as Woolworths Alexandra, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may only be delivered Monday to Sunday between the hours of 6.00am and 11.00pm.
- (c) No alcohol must be sold other than:
 - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - (v) A food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted
- (d) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday - 7.00am to 10.00pm
- (e) Only the area delineated on the attached plan dated 19 October 2022 is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol.
- (f) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (g) A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises.

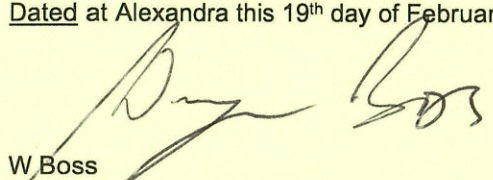
Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force-

- Until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire until the close of the period 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

Expiry date being **9 November 2026** unless renewed for a further period.
