

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **GENERAL DISTRIBUTORS LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol at the premises situated at **30 Grant Road, Frankton, Queenstown** and known as **"Countdown Queenstown"** to any person for consumption off the premises, and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day;
- b) No alcohol may be sold other than –
 - i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- c) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday 7:00 am to 11:00 pm

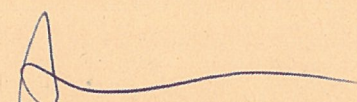
- d) Alcohol may only be displayed and promoted in the single-area as described in plans submitted to the District Licensing Committee on the 29th July 2019.
- e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions of the supply of alcohol to minors, the prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons, and identification of minors.
- f) According to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013 the premises is assigned the fees category: **High – Supermarket.**

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- a) Either-
 - i) Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii) If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
 - i) Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii) If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
