





GLOSSARY OF TERMS

- 1. Fake Fast pace: Pace analysis tools will be incorrect in this situation because in 'fake fast' situations, pacesetters are CORRECTLY IGNORED by riders that identify a 'runoff leader' that is going too fast early. This results in a pack that is running "a race within a race." Don't be too quick to downgrade Closers in such situations!
- 2. Accordion Flow: An 'accordion flow' is a dynamic that mostly occurs in turf routes. When leaders are successful in "backing down the pace" to catch a breather before sprinting for home, the field can crunch together before stretching out again, sometimes causing traffic issues for the back markers. In the majority of these instances, speed types and ground savers are the runners to benefit.
- 3. L: This is merely an abbreviation for "length."
- 4. "Tight" in-between vs "Loose" in-between : In-between racing is common in larger fields. "Tight" in-between positions cause stress and leave runners with tough options: (1) Progress and run the risk of moving too early. (2) Idle to move backwards results in position and ground loss. (3) Remaining in the same spot will likely result in the burning of needed energy.
- 5. Gapped leaders: Imagine a runoff leader and then (1) or (2) more rivals with a big advantage to the rest of the pack. These leading runners are out of position and chasing a leader that is VERY LIKELY going too fast early. Situations with "gapped leaders" offer a HUGE advantage to the Closers

TRIP NOTE: Was 6-1 ML. She hesitate and was off 1+L slow at the start, which is noted in the PPs. She saved ground near the back of the pack for much of the race, was forced to pause and lose 1L when ridden with extreme caution leaving the backstretch, and after a 3-4-5+W journey from the 3/16 pole to the top of the stretch, was fanned wider when inside runner drifted. A solid debut despite the slow start and minor incidents, she really flew home down the stretch to just miss, and galloped out HUGE.



TRIP NOTE: The PPs get it right. She showed nice speed and was looking to make the early lead, but she drifted in and suffered a negative bump, which stymied her speed which likely resulted in this rider opting for plan B - a stalking attempt. She prompted the leader while 2+W on the backstretch, was put into chase mode leaving the backstretch as teh pacesetter moved away from her and began an early move into the far turn, and after being bumped outward by an inside rival that was in search of clear sailing in the lane, finished evenly. A mostly neutral trip overall that suffered some minor trouble, she takes on more ground today and a new rider climbs aboard.



TRIP NOTE: ON DIRT: She was off 2L slow at the start, and then was reserved to avoid her blasting off too early. She raced IN HAND leaving the backstretch and made a decent advance while traveling 3-4W and gaining until she neared the 1/4 pole, and flattened. A tough trip given the poor start, it's worth noting that she has more speed than it might seem. She takes to the long turf game today.



TRIP NOTE: Nothing to add for this runner. She rated kindly and moved inward to race 2+W early, was eased 3+W on the backstretch and inched her way forward before putting in a big move as the far turn approached, and after getting stuck dueling through the far turn while 3-4W and between rivals, finished gamely to just miss place money. A solid debut given the wide journey vs the pace, she takes on more ground today.

RACE NOTE: (2) of the (9) runners were first-time starters. The pace was slow and a first-time starter from the Christophe Clement bard scored from a midpack position; she was a next-out 3rd vs OC 75k/ N1X-N foes as the 6-5*.

TRIP NOTE: The interesting thing about this runner is that she sppeared LOADED FOR BEAR entering the far turn, so much so that she had to tap on the brakes and steady to void running up on heels, but after a neutral path through the far turn and being tipped to the far outside in the lane, was flat. A neutral trip with the exception of the mild trouble at the 3F marker, she takes on more ground today.



TRIP NOTE: She was in a tight spot early and did have to steady to avoid a potentially bad situation, which cost her about 1L early. The rest of the trip however, was pretty good. She made her way to the rail early in the 1st turn, saved ground down the backstretch and into the far turn, and after taking a bit to ease outward and find a seam into the stretch, finished up evenly. A good trip overall, she takes on more ground today.



TRIP NOTE: She was sent pretty hard in the early stages to earn a forward position, which she did. She received a VERY GOOD into the clubhouse turn as this rider took to the inside to follow the leader, which allowed others to move up and stalk while outside - this secured her a cozy pocket spot. She raced in this very good position all the way around the track and was given an 'all out' cue to finish at the top of the stretch, but was even. A good trip from the outside post, she takes on a little more ground today.



TRIP NOTE: Was 9-2 ML. She broke great and easily cleared the runner to her inside before taking control of the pocket into the first turn. She maintained this great position throughout, was ridden with a lot of confidence in the far turn, and after bullying her way off the way by bumping common rival 'I'm a Sure Thing' out of the way into the home stretch, finished decently despite lugging inward and getting outfinished. A good trip throughout, her rider sees fit to try again in start #2.

HORSE NAME: Way too Early DATE: 1/8/23 **DISTANCE: 7 1/2 Furlongs** SURFACE: Turf

RACE NOTE: (5) of the (11) runners were first-time starters. The pace was normal and the 5-2* won from a stalking position. The 4th-place finisher was a nextout wire-to-wire winner vs the same level of competition but 'on synthetic.'

TRIP NOTE: Ignore the comments in the PPs as we're not sure which horse they were following but it definitely wasn't this one! She checked out of a tight spot early and lost ~3L overall, which is not noted in the PPs! She saved ground through the clubhouse turn and rated well at the inside down the backstretch, was finally eased off the inside to get around a stalling rival into the lane, (this is where the tape cuts as a runner that was vying for command broke down), and she finished well after being steered to the inside and racing two paths from the rail. A tough trip and nice performance given the start, it's also worth mentioning that every finisher benefited in this race as others did not complete the course.

HORSE NAME: Por Una Cabeza DATE: 1/8/23 **DISTANCE: 7 1/2 Furlongs** SURFACE: Turf

RACE NOTE: The pace was fast early and the only first time starter in the race won from a deep-closing position. This was essentially an 8-horse race as (3)rivals did not finish.

TRIP NOTE: ON DIRT: He drafted behind a lineup of (4) as the backstretch progressed, traveled 3W through much of the far turn before angling a bit wider to be given a chance to circle and level in the stretch, but despite leveling well and trying to reach a leader that had also enjoyed a nice journey throughout, was unable to earn top honors; a good trip throughout.



TRIP NOTE: He was the widest of (3) that vied for the lead leaving the backstretch, benefited from the rail runner backing out of the race into the far turn, and after dueling from a 2+W position throughout the far turn and through the stretch, got the short end of the stick by finishing 3rd in a 3horse photo. A neutral trip all considered, a new rider takes over.



TRIP NOTE: The comment that he was 'crowded early' is WRONG - ignore this information! He was thoughtfully idled to rate when a host of runners tried for the early lead, and he landed in a VERY GOOD stalking position. He followed a contested lead into the far turn while 2+W, made up a little ground before easing 3+W for a clear shot in the lane, but was outfinished. A good trip off of the layoff, blinkers are added as he takes on a little more ground.

He moved inward and bumped the inside rival entering the far turn, which sent that foe reeling to the back, and after racing head and head through the turn from the rail position, was overtaken at the 3/16 pole and weakened through the lane. A pace casualty on this day, he gives turf a try.



TRIP NOTE: The comment 'between' is completely misleading! Ignore it! He sat perched in a cozy outside spot while all by himself down the backstretch (a very good spot considering the pace), but when a rival on either side approached as the far turn neared, he was forced to quicken to hold his position, but he offered no resistance before descending to the back of the pack. A good trip given the pace and position early, he'll need to improve.



TRIP NOTE: He showed good speed and was idled to take a stalking position into the far turn, but when common rival 'Chief Council' rated and abruptly stopped into the turn, he backed right into this one, and 'Orth' checked to the back of the pack. A terrible trip given the obvious trouble that ended his chances after just 1/4 mile, the rider sees fit to try again.



TRIP NOTE: He was off ~2L slow at the start, which is not noted in the PPs! He traveled in hand down the backstretch, began to make his move in the far turn and angled 3-4-5W to earn a clear shot in the lane, but was unable to gain when those in front of him had plenty left in the tank. A tough trip given the poor start and even pace, a new rider takes over.



TRIP NOTE: Boy was this a bad trip. He was knocked around pretty badly away from the gate, losing ~2L overall, but after gaining nicely on the backstretch, landed in a terrible in-between spot and without options into the far turn. He'd eventually steady backwards and was shuffled, recovered for a 2nd time to try and bully his way to the outside into the lane, but was hemmed in. A miserable trip and nice showing of talent at 60-1 odds should be upgraded!



TRIP NOTE: ON SYNTHETIC: It only took him 12 strides to earn a 2L advantage before being put on hold to save for the last 3/16. He cruised unopposed throughout, was finally asked to leave the pack nearing the stretch drive, and took off through the stretch while receiving some appreciative petting from his jockey near the finish. A good trip and DOMINANT performance on the synthetic, he tries tougher and moves to the dirt course today.

He showed nice speed to recover and follow the outside stalker through the far turn, was eased 3+W in the late stages of the far turn for a clean shot in the lane, and did very good work to overhaul and the leaders and hold sway; a dominant performance given the incident at the start, it's worth noting that he also showed off strong body language on the gallop out.



TRIP NOTE: ON SYNTHETIC: He showed nice speed to clear the runners to his inside and take control of the pocket late on the backstretch. He saved ground into the far turn and did nice work to protect the rail vs an outside rival, made a nice advance and began easing 2-3+W at the 1/4 pole, and was dominant in the final 3/16 as he received a light shove through the lane to score EASILY! A good trip throughout, he pivots back to the turf course today.



TRIP NOTE: We have nothing to add for this runner. He raced under a snug hold leaving the backstretch, was angled 3-4W from the 5/16 pole in order to ensure a clear trip and finished willingly before finally flattening in the late stages. A neutral trip throughout, he secures the circuit's top rider.

TRIP NOTE: The comment 'inside, no response' is accurate. He was (1) of (4) that tried for the early lead, and was thoughtfully reserved to avoid the duel and take to the inside. He saved ground while in close proximity to a fast pace through for most of the race, but faltered when he reached the top of the stretch. A neutral trip that was without any visual clues, a check of the tote seems to be in order as he cuts back in distance.

RACE NOTE: The pace was VERY FAST early and **TRACK I** Closers had the advantage and performed best.

TRIP NOTE: The comment that he was 'bumped at the start' is laughable! Ignore this information! He was urged into the clubhouse turn, but did so while progressing into a box and without options, which landed him traveling in-between rivals through the first turn. He traveled in a 'loose in-between' spot on the backstretch, was put to work to gain while racing nearest the inside in the far turn, and failed to threaten. A mostly neutral trip after some tough spots early, he draws well today.



TRIP NOTE: He was a bit keen as a result of the slow early pace, and he paused a bit to avoid getting into more serious trouble into the first turn, but the remainder of the trip was good. He raced in a loose pocket from the rail throughout, did good work to advance and protect his rail spot when asked outside of the 1/4 pole, but was even in the stretch while also coughing up a couple of spots. A good trip overall, it's important to note that he hadn't raced in over a year!



TRIP NOTE: He raced head and head for the lead in the VERY EARLY stages, but was thoughtfully reserved to take control of the pocket into the clubhouse turn. He raced in this good spot through the 1st turn and onto the backstretch, began to receive some coaxing and then increased pressure as the backstretch progressed, and faltered in the turn. A good trip throughout that offered no visual clues, the rider that guided him on debut takes the call again.



TRIP NOTE: He held a stalking position of a clear leader early, but when that leader began to move away from the pack, he was thoughtfully idled to take back a bit; this was a smart ride. He traveled 2-3W through the first turn, raced 3W down the backstretch and into the far turn, and was even in the lane, getting past the fatigued pacesetter but not threatening the 1-2 finishers. A neutral journey overall, this was a pretty good try for not having competed in nearly 2 years.



TRIP NOTE: There are a few things to note for this runner: 1) He was off a touch slow and then bumped outward, which cost him ~1L and several potential positions. 2) He was keen for most of the race, which certainly didn't give him the best chance of finishing well! 3) After moving inward and taking control of the pocket on the backstretch and into the far turn, he suffered some unidentified trouble that resulted in a loss of 1+L and also the jockey losing an iron. A tough trip off of the layoff, he stands to move way up with a clean break and a more relaxed journey.



TRIP NOTE: The comments in the PPs would suggest a pretty bad trip early - NONSENSE! While he did break inward and gently touch the runner to his inside, the contact meant nothing! While rating and looking for a place to settle early, he was tightened up a bit and forced to pause, but the trouble only cost him about 1/2 length, and he settled immediately thereafter; take this information LIGHTLY at the most! He raced 3W through the first turn, 4-3W down the backstretch while uncovered, and 2+W through the far turn, and never threatened. A mostly neutral trip, he looks for a wakeup call by removing the blinkers.



She was urged to keep up in the far turn, had her spot overtaken by an outside rival early in the stretch, and was slightly outrun thereafter while moving inward as the stretch drive progressed. A neutral trip throughout.



TRIP NOTE: The broke best and landed in a very nice stalking spot while following a contested lead while on the clear outside, traveling with a runner to her inside. She traveled 2+W through the far turn and was urged to advance and kick in the last 5/16, but never threatened, winning a 3-horse photo for 4th place money. A good trip vs better, she receives class relief and a SIGNIFICANT rider upgrade today.



TRIP NOTE: ON DIRT: She progressed into a very good spot on the backstretch, targeting open air to a paid or rivals that were keeping each other honest on the lead. She traveled 3W into the turn and was inching her way towards the leaders when a rival to her outside gained and needed to quicken to hold her off, but she overtaken by the outside Closer. A good trip 'on dirt.' she changes surfaces in start #2 off of the short break.



TRIP NOTE: She broke well and landed in a forward and uncovered position down the backstretch, following a 99-1 pacesetter and a 2-1 stalker. She raced 3W into the far turn while following what had become a brief pace duel on the lead, gained nicely as the far turn progressed, but lost the battle to 'centrifugal force' and drifted 4-5W late in the far turn before leveling VERY WELL through the stretch to win EASILY. A poor turf trip on this day, it's worth noting that she showed off strong body language on the gallop out!

TRIP NOTE: She followed the outside stalker and traveled 3+W through the far turn; not ideal as turf sprints are concerned. She overtook the outside stalker and took aim on the pacesetter, but despite doing VERY GOOD WORK through the lane and finishing strongly, was unable to outfinish two rivals that had enjoyed sweet trips throughout - the uncontested pacesetter and the winner that had 'sat the pocket' throughout. This was a solid performance after a poor turf trip.



TRIP NOTE: She held a cozy pocket position down the backstretch while following a longshot leader that carved out dawdling fractions; this was a GREAT SPOT. She steadied just a touch when the far turn arrived as the pacesetter slowed to turn (this was VERY MINOR trouble that shouldn't be considered), but immediately and easily eased one path off the rail to engage the leader. She raced 2+W through the far turn to increase the tempo and sprint for home, and did the best work in the last 1/4 to earn the win; a good trip throughout!
