





### **GLOSSARY OF TERMS**

- 1. Fake Fast pace: Pace analysis tools will be incorrect in this situation because in 'fake fast' situations, pacesetters are CORRECTLY IGNORED by riders that identify a 'runoff leader' that is going too fast early. This results in a pack that is running "a race within a race." Don't be too quick to downgrade Closers in such situations!
- 2. Accordion Flow: An 'accordion flow' is a dynamic that mostly occurs in turf routes. When leaders are successful in "backing down the pace" to catch a breather before sprinting for home, the field can crunch together before stretching out again, sometimes causing traffic issues for the back markers. In the majority of these instances, speed types and ground savers are the runners to benefit.
- 3. L: This is merely an abbreviation for "length."
- 4. "Tight" in-between vs "Loose" in-between : In-between racing is common in larger fields. "Tight" in-between positions cause stress and leave runners with tough options: (1) Progress and run the risk of moving too early. (2) Idle to move backwards results in position and ground loss. (3) Remaining in the same spot will likely result in the burning of needed energy.
- 5. Gapped leaders: Imagine a runoff leader and then (1) or (2) more rivals with a big advantage to the rest of the pack. These leading runners are out of position and chasing a leader that is VERY LIKELY going too fast early. Situations with "gapped leaders" offer a HUGE advantage to the Closers

**TRIP NOTE:** ON DIRT: We have nothing to add for this runner. He raced near the back while on hold and drafting behind the speed, but when the pace picked up into the far turn, he was unable to keep pace with the leaders. A clean journey that was 'vs the pace,' he gives a new surface a try today.



**TRIP NOTE:** There are two things to consider for this runner's trip : 1) He broke inward and hit the gate before getting slammed outward, which cost him 1+L leaving the gate! 2) He moved inward on the backstretch and was looking to advance while in-between when the field reached the far turn, but he was crowded and forced to steady, which cost him another length, which is not noted in the PPs! He raced 3-4W in the second half of the far turn when looking to gain and level into the stretch, and was even. A tough trip sprinting, he returns from the short break from racing and takes on more ground.



**TRIP NOTE:** He enjoyed a pretty good trip for most of the race as he saved ground and was able to choose his path on the backstretch, but when traveling well and responding to urging in the far turn, he appeared to stall when launching a big to try and split rivals, which goes unmentioned in the PPs. he eventually emerged from the in-between spot, and he was OK in the stretch, but we do believe that there was some mild trouble in what was a good trip otherwise.



**TRIP NOTE:** He was outquicked early and relegated to a deep closing position, and was never involved, offering no visual clues. The class relief makes sense.

**RACE NOTE:** The pace was normal and the A-B choices on the tote board finished 1-2. The show finisher was a next-out winner of the ColLiam-L200k Stakes. The 6th place finisher was a next-out (easy) winner of the JBttglaM-L147k Stakes at TP.



**TRIP NOTE:** The PPs are a bit deceiving for this runner. Yes, he was clear, but the stalker that kept him honest on the front end had about 6+L on the rest of the field, which means that if not for the race stalker, he could have really backed down the pace in this race. He began to inch away from his tracking rival into the far turn, was coaxed to pick up the pace as the race favorite approached near the stretch, and he finished gamely in the lane to hold sway. A good win and game performance after a trip that we'll label as neutral, a new rider takes over for a runner that looks to make his turf record 3-3.



**TRIP NOTE:** The PPs tell the story. He raced unopposed for most of the race, was finally approached with a little more than 5/16 to go and urged to resist, but after being put to a drive nearing the 1/4 pole, was overtaken by several rivals at the furlong pole. A good trip vs better, he receives Lasix and a new rider in his return from the layoff.



**TRIP NOTE:** ON DIRT: He showed good speed and was a length and a tail behind the leader, but was also in a tough in-between spot, which resulted in the jockey taking him backwards to avoid a bad spot throughout. This concession cost 1+L and is not noted in the PPs. He eased to the outside and quickly made up the lost ground (cost him some fuel), traveled 3-4W through the far turn, and weakened in the stretch. A tough trip given the early position and mild trouble, a new rider takes over.



**TRIP NOTE:** He was off a touch slow and squeezed pretty bad, losing his path and 2+L at the start. This bad beginning is noted in the PPs. He recovered while under urging and traveled 3W leaving the backstretch, raced 3-4-5W as the far turn progressed, and was given a token ride through the lane. A tough trip to all but get eliminated at the start, we'd take this performance with a grain of salt as it was alos vs his running style.

**TRIP NOTE:** He was given a VERY GOOD ride to slip up the rail on the backstretch and pick off a handful of runners before landing in the pocket, and when the top (2) kicked away from the others with 5/16 to go, this runner did EXCELLENT WORK to take aim and reel them in through the stretch. A good trip throughout, this was also a very strong performance, and he galloped out EXTREMELY WELL also!



**TRIP NOTE:** ON SYNTHETIC: He received a very good ride in the first turn to slightly pause to allow an inside runner to move 2+W and stalk, while quickly taking to the inside and earning the pocket. He raced in this very good position for most of the race, eased off the rail and worked his way around a stalling leader early in the far turn, and after pushing his way into the clear for the stretch drive, left the pack with ease. A very good trip throughout, he gives the turf course another try today.



**TRIP NOTE:** The comment in the PPs is all you need to know. He saved ground all the way around the course while following the pocket runner, but despite never having to leave the fence and having a clear shot in the lane, was never involved. A new rider takes the call.



**TRIP NOTE:** In his 2nd stride from the gate he tripped and lost all kinds of speed (-2+L), which relegated him to last in the early stages. He lagged at the back, saved ground throughout, and was never involved despite gaining a bit in the stretch, but you'd have to think he'd have been much closer with a clean start. He returns to the races as a first time gelding today.

**TRIP NOTE:** This was simply a 3+W journey while uncovered throughout,but the most notable information would be that she was stalling and being overtaken by rivals in the far turn, but then was re-engaged in the stretch and managed to pick up a minor award. A slightly wide journey on this day, she's been freshened for her try at a shorter distance.

She saved ground through the turn, was eventually eased 2+W from the 1/4 pole, and grinded away through the lane to take home show money, GALLOPING OUT HUGE after the race! A good trip overall, the post race energy was the real tip off for this runner!

He traveled sweetly throughout while under a snug hold at the rail, awaited room patiently as the stretch drived neared, and was given ample opportunity up the rail, spurted nicely up the fence to take control and hold sway vs a pacesetter that tried to re-rally and take back his lead. A good trip throughout, he's confidently jumped in class today.



TRIP NOTE: He emerged from in-between horses to take a short advantage vs his stalking rivals into the far turn, was put to a full out drive outside of the 5/16, and when put in a bit tight when the leader drifted into the lane, cut to the inside in the stretch and leveled very well to earn place money. This was a solid try after being forced to compete in a spot when the real racing was getting going.



TRIP NOTE: He was the widest of (3) that chased a clear leader through the far turn, but when a wide rival joined the party in the far turn, he was forced to sprint to hold his spot while 4-5W. A bad spot during a critical time in the race, he'd lose position and then have to angle wide and re-rally, which he actually did, although it doesn't read well in the PPs!



**TRIP NOTE:** He held a clear stalking spot while on the outside throughout. He advanced as the field left the backstretch, traveled through the far turn while being ridden with a lot of confidence, and after taking away the lead without any real resistance into the stretch, finished strongly to leave the pack. A very good trip throughout, he draws the rail today.



**TRIP NOTE:** He raced unopposed for most of the race, was given a thoughtful ride in the far turn when coaxed to 'get away' from the pack, but was unable to resist the race favorite as that one driven past before the stretch drive ever arrived. A good trip on the front end, it's worth noting that this runner was quite game through the stretch as it appeared he was weakening, but he battled back while nearest the rail through the lane to take home place money. This was a good trip and game try vs better.



**TRIP NOTE:** He shared the lead with a rival to his inside while carving out slow fractions vs a compact field; this was a good spot. He emerged from the pack to take a short lead entering the stretch, and finished VERY WELL in the lane as these top two separated themselves from the others.



**TRIP NOTE:** He lagged at the back of a very compact field early, traveled widest through the far turn (3-4-5W as the turn progressed to the stretch), and after struggling to make progress in the lane, finally changed leads and finished nicely to barely snatch place money right on the finish line. A tough trip given the wide journey vs the pace, there was nothing wrong with this effort.

A tough trip throughout deserves an extra look!



**TRIP NOTE:** He followed the outside stalker while a bit wider and in the clear, but when traveling through the far turn, he was overtaken by the back markers and seemed destine to run last, but then stayed on well through the stretch despite failing to gain. A clean and neutral trip off of the short layoff, this performance is a bit of a head scratcher.

A poor turf trip to press the pace from the outside, the jockey sees fit to try again.



**TRIP NOTE:** The PPs tell the story. She stalked a duel between a massive longshot and the second betting choice throughout, journeyed 2-3W while in hand thorugh the far turn, and drew away in the lane to win impressively. A perfect trip vs the MSW crew, she takes on stakes company with a new rider.



**TRIP NOTE:** ON DIRT: She raced in the clear while stalking a contested lead and fast pace while wide on the course down the backstretch, made a decent move to advance while 4-4+W in the far turn, but when it came time to finish, she weakened a bit and failed to get past either of the dueling leaders. A neutral trip all considered (vs better and on a different surface), she cuts back and moves to the turf course.



**TRIP NOTE:** She maintained control of the pocket position throughout, cut the corner beautifully into the stretch to take advantage of a clear lane that was left by a leader that traveled 2+W into the stretch, and was very professional into the stretch to spurt clear and comfortably hold sway. A great trip throughout.


