

Step 3: Enhance

How do dryer sheets benefit you and your clothes?

• When your clothes are in the dryer, an electrostatic charge builds up called static cling.

• Bounce Free & Gentle, free from perfumes, reduces static cling, stopping your clothes from being a magnet to dust and hair.

• This results in your clothes acting like a magnet for hair and dust particles, which can pose a real challenge to sensitive skin.

Common mistake
