FREE TRAVEL SCHEME

Brighton & Hove Albion offers away fans free travel on trains and buses within the Free Travel Zone

- **3pm Kick-off**
Use your match tickets between **11.30pm** and **9pm**
- **7.45pm Kick-off**
Use your match tickets between **4.15pm** and **midnight**





FREE TRAVEL – TRAIN ZONE



- Brighton station is served by direct trains from Gatwick Airport and London (Victoria, London Bridge or St. Pancras)

- Trains from Brighton to Falmer take 7 minutes. Trains are very busy on a matchday and fans should try and board a train from Brighton one hour before kick-off

VISITING FAN ACCESS

Access into the South Stand

- ❑ Turnstiles open 2 hours before kick-off
- ❑ We are a cashless stadium
- ❑ Security checks on entry including pyro & drug dogs, searching, bag checks
- ❑ Flags need pre-approval from South Stand Manager and a fire safety certificate will need to be presented





STADIUM GUIDELINES

Prohibited items and ground regulations

No Smoking

The stadium is a **No Smoking** environment. Smoking (including the use of e-cigarettes/vapes) is not permitted in any part of the Ground and will result in ejection from the Ground

CCTV
