- Brighton & Hove Albion offers away fans free travel\* on trains and buses within the Free Travel Zone
- You can use the free train travel service from 3.5 hours before kick-off and to have started your journey within 3.5 hours after the final whistle.
- If Supporters choose to remain at the AMEX outside of these times, then they must pay for their own onward travel to and/ or from the AMEX. Any Supporters seeking to use the free travel scheme outside of the operating hours without paying for their travel, may be asked to leave the travel service and may receive a fine from the travel operator.

## FREE TRAVEL - TRAIN ZONE



- Brighton station is served by direct trains from Gatwick Airport and London (Victoria, London Bridge or St. Pancras)
- Trains from Brighton to Falmer take 7 minutes. Trains are very busy on a matchday and fans should try and board a train from Brighton one hour before kick-off





## FREE TRAVEL – BUS ZONE



All Brighton and Hove Buses & Stagecoach Coastline 700

You can use the free bus travel scheme from 3.5 hours before kick-off up until 3.5 hours after the final whistle. You must have started your journey home within the 3.5 hours of the final whistle.
