We can make a difference with our own initiatives, both now and in the future, and we are totally committed to doing so.

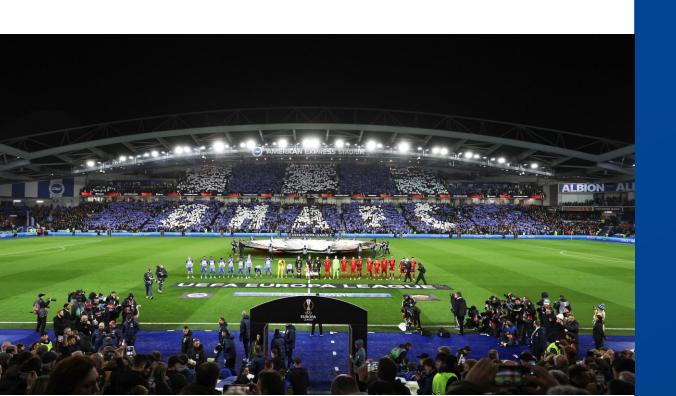
As a signatory of the UNFCC Sports for Climate Action Framework, Brighton & Hove Albion are committed to halving emissions by 2030 and achieving net-zero by 2040.

These targets aim to position sport as a pace setter for climate action and signatories are required to have robust carbon reduction plans and report annually on their carbon footprint.



VISION

To establish the club as one of the most environmentally sustainable clubs in world football by 2030.



MISSION

To reduce the environmental impacts from the club's facilities, operations and supply chain, and minimise our use of resources, whilst succeeding at the top-level of professional football.

We will use our position in football to promote environmental responsibility and support our staff, fans and communities to live healthier, more sustainable lives.



PRIORITIES

The club have identified objectives across six key areas to target and prioritise action.

Energy & water

- Improve energy and water efficiency
- Increase renewable energy generation
- Decarbonise heating systems



Supply Chain

- Ensure an ethical and sustainable supply chain
- Include sustainability principles in all purchasing decisions



Travel & transport

- Encourage and support fans and staff to use low-carbon travel options
- Promote the uptake of Electric Vehicles (EV) and EV infrastructure



Biodiversity

- Enhance biodiversity on our own sites
- Promote the conservation of nature more widely



Waste

- Minimise waste and increase reuse and recycling
- Find alternatives to single-use-plastics
- Embed Circular Economy principles across the club



Culture & community

- Establish a culture of care for people and planet
- Encourage and support our communities to live healthier more sustainable lives

For each of the priority areas, action plans will be enacted with clear responsibilities, timelines and sufficient budget

Continuing engagement with key stakeholders to better understand our impact and identify new opportunities
