

# Where Should I Bring My Pet?



## PRIMARY CARE VET

(make an appointment)

sneezing or runny nose

coughing without respiratory distress

itchy ears or skin

scooting

limping

hot spots

vomiting/diarrhea 1-2x within 24 hours but acting normal

broken nail



## URGENT CARE VET

vomiting/diarrhea with change in behavior

eyes: redness, discharge, or squinting

porcupine quills

blood in urine or stool

wounds & injuries

lameness, difficulty walking

allergic reactions

tick-borne disease



## EMERGENCY HOSPITAL

foreign body or toxin ingestion

serious trauma (i.e. hit by car)

cannot breathe, choking

unconsciousness/collapse

broken bone

bloating, retching, or unproductive vomiting

straining or unable to defecate or urinate

snake bite
