


Seeking Dogs to Assist with Improvement of Cancer Diagnostics (Most Dogs Qualify)

Ethos is committed to assisting the validation of improved cancer diagnostics by providing crucial samples. In order to help, we need whole blood and serum samples from healthy dogs (1), dogs with specific cancers (2), and dogs with non-cancerous conditions that are associated with cancer (3).

Eligibility criteria:

- 
- Dog weighs more than 2 kgs (4.4 lbs)
 - Dog is any age, unless if they plan on enrolling as healthy
 - Healthy patients must be between 1 and 6 years old
 - They belong to one of the groups described above (1-3).
 - No prior treatment with corticosteroids, chemotherapeutics, radiation, or other immunomodulatory agents before study enrollment



- This trial requires only a single study visit.
- If patient is healthy, their owner will also receive one check-in phone call 6 months later.



- For Clients: \$150 Hospital Credit, plus, an additional \$100 towards histological confirmation in patients without previous histology.
- For DVMs/Techs: \$75/case to be paid via Visa giftcard.
