- MASH has three full time VSWs (Veterinary Social Workers), licensed mental health clinicians, who provide free clinical support for clients and staff.

- VSWs provide services for both staff and clients including but not limited to:
 - Short term grief/anticipatory grief counseling
 - Pet loss support group (3x a month via Zoom)
 - End of life support
 - Crisis Intervention
 - Liaisoning between client and veterinary team
 - Euthanasia Support
 - Referrals to resources
- VSWs <u>do not</u> provide ongoing therapy, although if therapy is needed, VSW may be able to assist with finding a long term clinician.
