



Preventative Care Days 2025

Spring is around the corner, which means Allegheny Equine's annual Preventative Care Days are quickly approaching and we want to get your horse on our schedule! This program allows us to maximize our veterinarian's day by minimizing travel time between farm calls while also decreasing fuel costs. These savings are then passed on to you.

Starting in February, we will begin scheduling a veterinarian in a limited geographical area to perform **only** the following preventative health care services:

By signing up for one of our prescheduled days, you receive a discounted farm call. A regular farm call cost is \$93 to \$111 but if you schedule for one of our Preventative Care Days when a veterinarian is scheduled to be in the area, your farm call is just **\$41.86 per client**.

Please Note:

- * This program is for individuals, not large boarding barns where farm calls are already split amongst multiple clients.
- * Services offered on Preventative Care Days are limited to what is listed above. Any additional services needed (eye exams, lameness exams, illness etc.) will require a regular scheduled appointment on another day.
- * You will not be able to pick your doctor, the schedule is preset with assigned doctors.
- * Payment is required at the time of service in the form of cash, check, or credit card to be processed same day.

Scheduling:

- * This year, we've updated our scheduling protocol to make it more convenient for clients when they call in to schedule their PCD appointment. You can request a PCD appointment on our website (<https://www.alleghenyequine.net/preventative-care-days-program>) or call our office at (724) 325-4615 & select option 2. Please leave your name, your phone number, and the **exact address** of where your horse is located. Offering the exact address is beneficial to both clients and the office staff so that we can accommodate your scheduling needs. Our office staff will reach out within 24 hours and will provide you with the dates that we have available.
- * Days fill on a first come, first served basis. Many days reach full capacity, we strongly suggest calling earlier rather than later.
- * *We will need 4 clients scheduled per area to run a PCD Day so talk to your neighbors!*



Below you will find a schedule of where we will be on specific dates. Examples of common towns/cities for each area are provided. The maximum range for a farm call is 40 miles from our clinic (based on GPS directions); see additional route restrictions below.
