Know the Signs

- Bleeding
- Unconsciousness
- Difficulty Breathing
- Bloat
- Heatstroke
- Labor/Delivery Difficulties
- Paralysis
- Penetrating Wound
- Poisoning
- Seizures
- Trauma
- · Vomiting/Diarrhea

Take Action



- 1. Stay Calm
- 2. Secure and Stabilize Your Animal
- 3. Drive Carefully to Your Nearest Emergency Hospital
- 4. Call Ahead, If Possible
