Summer is a time for fun, but it brings serious risks for pets, especially during holiday celebrations. Keep your furry family members safe with these quick tips:



Firework Safety

- Keep pets indoors in a quiet, secure space.
- Update ID tags & microchips in case they escape.
- Never bring pets to fireworks shows.



BBQ & Party Hazards

- Dangerous foods: Bones, fatty meats, onions, grapes, and alcohol.
- Keep grill tools & trash out of reach.
- Secure leftovers and trash bins.



Heat & Humidity Safety

- Never leave pets in parked cars.
- Walk pets during cooler times (morning or evening).
- Watch for heatstroke signs:
- Panting, drooling, weakness, vomiting, collapse.



Protect Against Pests

- Use year-round flea, tick, & heartworm preventatives.
- Check pets for ticks after outdoor activities.

Know What to Do in an Emergency Seek Immediate Help If Your Pet:

- Has difficulty breathing or collapses
- Has burns, cuts, or other trauma
- Has persistent vomiting or diarrhea
- Has ingested toxic foods or substances
- Shows signs of heatstroke or severe dehydration
