## ORTHOPEDIC SURGERY



From the most common injuries to complicated fracture repair, our surgeon has the expertise and state-of-the-art equipment to care for your pet.

#### Common orthopedic procedures performed:

- Tibial Plateau Leveling Osteotomy (TPLO) for cranial cruciate ligament injuries
- Patellar Luxation Correction
- Fracture Repair
- Treatment of joint injuries/luxations
- Total Hip Replacement (THR) and Femoral Head Ostectomy (FHO) for hip dysplasia and osteoarthritis

## MINIMALLY INVASIVE PROCEDURES

#### Common minimally invasive techniques include:

- Arthroscopy for conditions involving joints
- Thoracoscopy for conditions within the chest cavity
- · Laparoscopy for conditions within the abdominal cavity
