

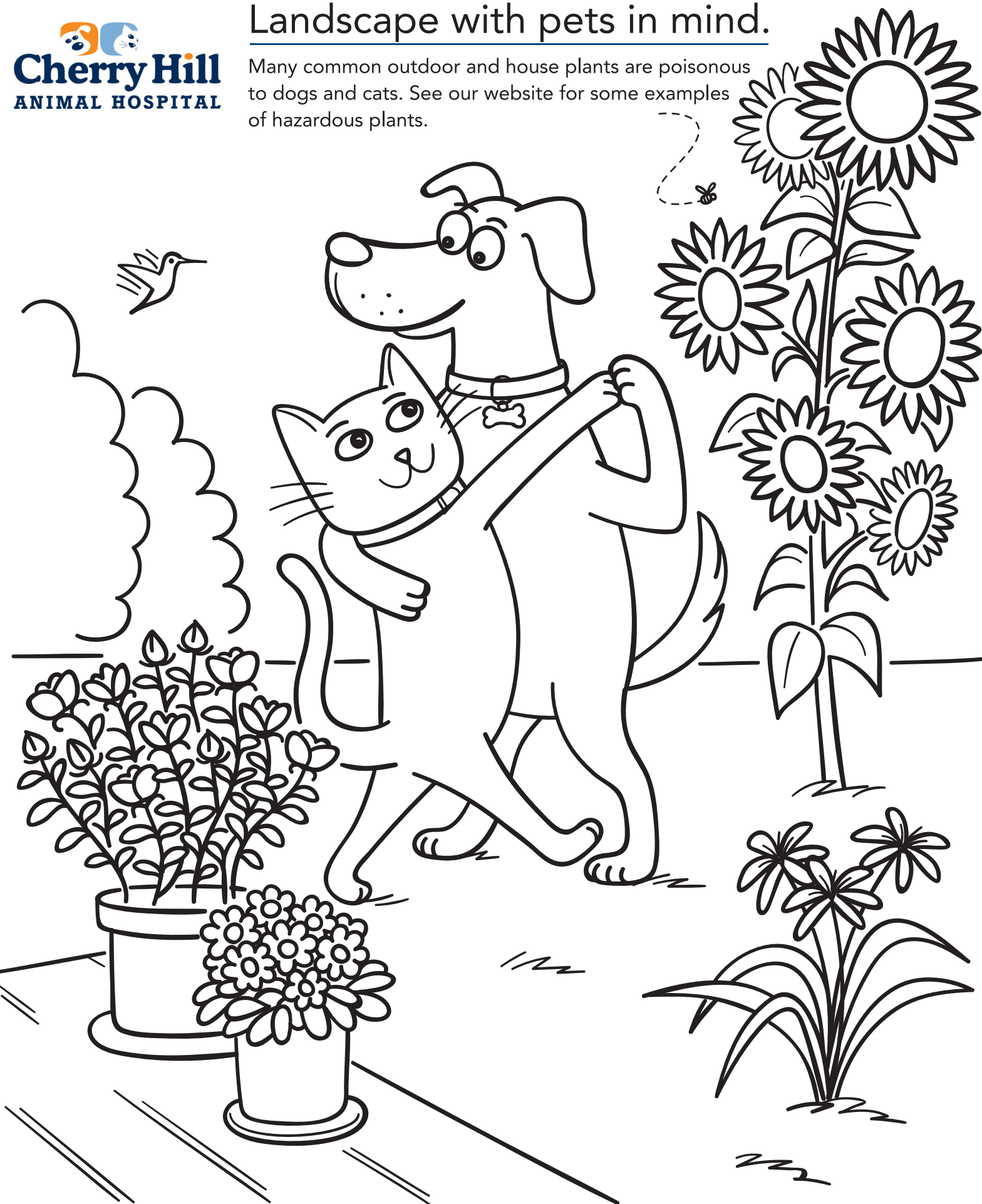
## Fun in and out of the sun.

## Help your dog keep his cool.

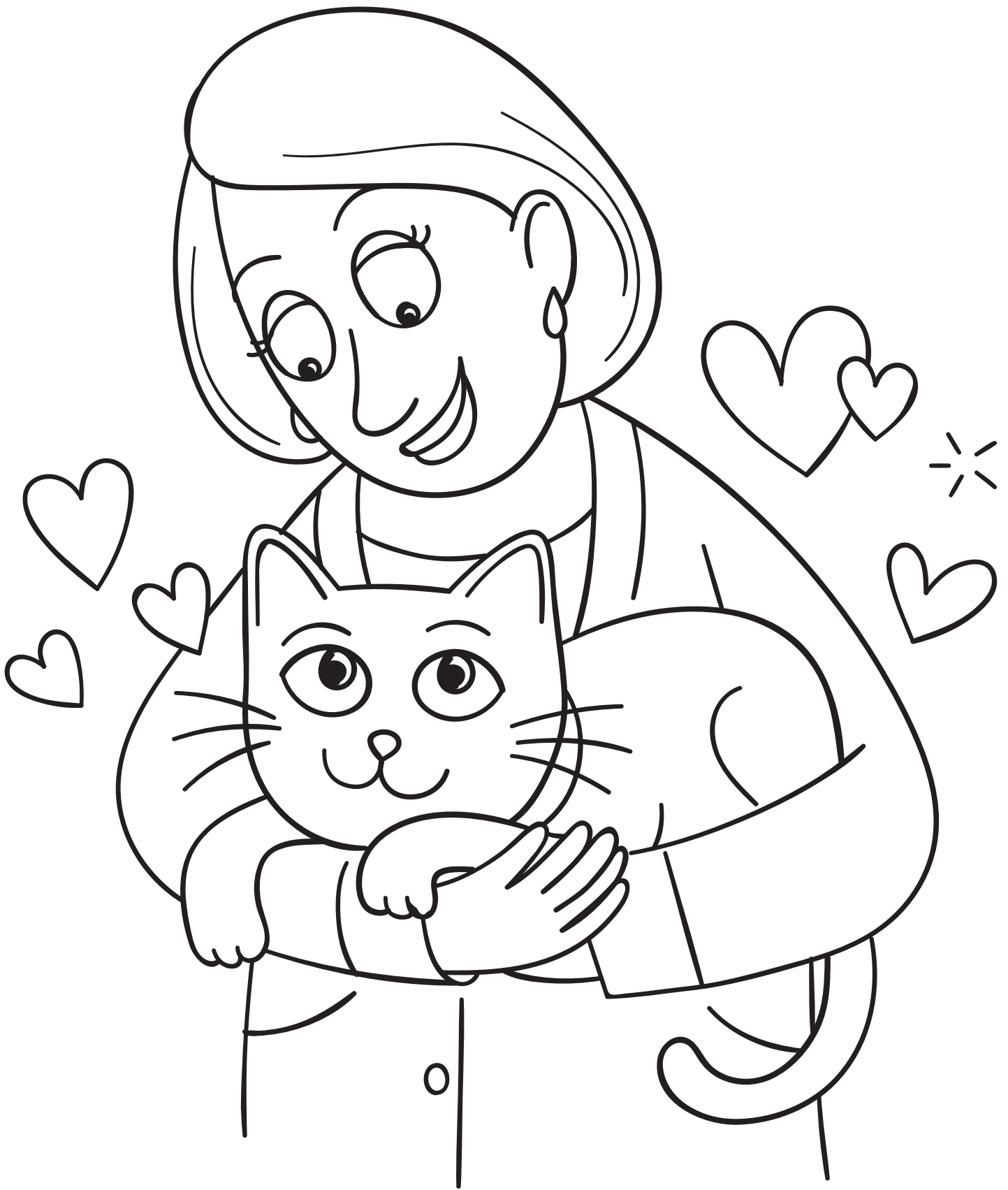
Never leave your dog in a car, because the temperature inside can rise quickly. Your dog will be much happier at home holding down your couch.
