May we feed your cat Prescription Hypoallergenic treats? Y N The hypoallergenic treats are tolerated by most every cat and are delicious!

May we feed your cat Prescription i/d (chicken-based intestinal diet)? Y N This food is important if stomach upset occurs. Opting out is only recommended for allergies.

Would you like us to administer gabapentin morning of discharge to help with car ride? Y N The doctor may determine that your cat will benefit from gabapentin & administer based on their demeanor.

Can your pet have catnip? Y N Would your cat like a small scratching board? Y N

Does your cat need a high litterbox? (kicks litter out or urinates over edge) Y N

BOARDING CARE We will offer support as needed to help your cat during their stay as long as we can do while minimizing exposure to our staff (e.g. lower dose Gabapentin, Mirtazapine (appetite stimulant), Cerenia (anti-nausea) or probiotic (for soft stool). Approved (please initial)
