### **Procedural Tweaks**

<u>Prescription refills</u> – we are asking for <u>24 hours</u> for Pharmacy refills. This is
for the benefit of your pet and the accuracy of refilling all medication. With
weight changes and vendor and dosage changes it is always better for us to
take our time and make sure what we script out is correct. We want to
make sure you get the most up to date and accurate medication based on
any changes in your pet's health and weight.

- <u>Drop off appointments</u> verses walk in appointments. We are asking that all non-emergent appointments be made with a veterinarian as an appointment, or be dropped off so we may work your pet in throughout the day. Walk ins will be available for emergency visits and Sick pet visits. We want to help as many pets as we can, but there is limited time in a day and we want to prioritize each visit with its need or illness, while still giving great service to those that have made appointments.
- <u>All Payments</u> are due at the time of service. We accept, all forms of payment and Care Credit as well. Please ask us how to apply for care credit we will be happy to help.
