What to do to prepare for the appointment:

Our internal medicine department often evaluates the most complex cases, those that are difficult to diagnose and therapeutically manage. In order to do that, we need as many records from other veterinarians as possible. *Please help ensure we have everything we need by reaching out to any veterinarians that have seen your pet in the last 5 years and requesting that they send us ALL medical notes, lab results, x-rays and any other diagnostic tests and results 1-3 days prior to your appointment.*
