

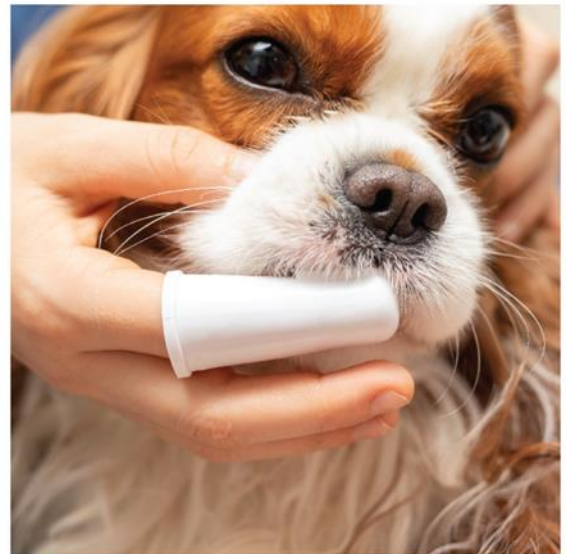
Purr-fect smiles start with great dental care.



- **Brush your dog's teeth daily starting when your puppy is six to eight months old.**
- **Consider professional dental cleaning once a year, especially for breeds with smaller mouths.**
- **Have your pet's teeth checked sooner if you observe any of the following problems:**
 - Bad breath
 - Broken or loose teeth
 - Extra teeth or retained baby teeth
 - Teeth that are discolored or covered in tartar
 - Abnormal chewing, drooling, or dropping food from the mouth
 - Reduced appetite or refusal to eat
 - Pain in or around the mouth
 - Bleeding from the mouth
 - Swelling in the areas surrounding the mouth
