Strategic Vaccination and Deworming Guidelines for Cats

An exam with the Doctor is required

- 2 weeks old** – Deworm
- 4 weeks old** – Deworm
- 6 weeks old** – 1st FVRCP
Intestinal Parasite Screening (Fecal)
Deworm
Optional: FIV/FeLV/Heartworm Test
Optional: 1st FeLV*
Begin Flea & Heartworm preventatives (must be 8 weeks old)
- 10-14 weeks old** – 2nd FVRCP
Deworm
Rabies (If 12 weeks old)
Optional: 2nd FeLV*
Flea & Heartworm preventatives
- Annual** – FVRCP
Rabies
Intestinal Parasite Screening (Fecal)
Profender Topical (Dewormer)
Optional: FIV/FeLV/Heartworm Test
Optional: 1st FeLV*
Flea & Heartworm preventatives
- Newly Acquired Cats** – Annual (FVRCP must be boosted 4 weeks after 1st vaccine.
Flea & Heartworm preventatives

*All cats receiving the FeLV (Feline Leukemia) prevention vaccine must be tested before vaccine can be given.

Rabies vaccination and registration is mandatory in the state of Texas
