

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is the cost for boarding?

A: We have several options! This is dependent on age and medical needs. Pricing will vary dependent on the boarding accommodations.

Q: Should I bring my own food?

A: The choice is yours! We carry Science Diet Maintenance wet & dry food as well as the Prescription Diet's (Hill's & Royal Canin) if your cat is on a prescription diet. Otherwise you can bring your fur baby's preferred food.

Q: Will my cat receive any playtime?

A: Yes, absolutely! We have to clean don't we?! During the multiple times a day when we refresh your cat's accommodations, your fur baby has free roam of the designated boarding area where they safely play with toy mice and get lots of love, attention, and kisses from our caregivers!

Q: Will my cat(s) interact with other cats?

A: While your cat will be able to see other cats that are boarding, they will not have direct face-to-face contact! This is for the safety of our boarders as well as our staff. Only one family is out for playtime at a time!

Q: What if my cat is on medication?

A: No problem! Our trained technicians administer medications to our boarders as often as needed.

Q: Can I tour the facility?

A: We encourage it! Give us a call anytime to schedule a tour of our feline only practice!

Q: Can I bring my cat's toys & bedding?

A: Of course! However, if their belongings get soiled during their stay, we will wash them. Like the 'lost dryer sock' some things may not make it back, so we encourage keeping kitty's favorite things at home.

Which boarding accommodation is right for my cat?

For all cats under 15 years old, we offer two boarding options: Condo or Regular.

Our Regular accommodations are 28" deep, 27.5" wide, and 21" tall.

Each accommodation includes:

- Litter box
- Food & water bowls
- Towel & comfy bedding

Our Condo accommodations are 26" deep, 33" wide, and 25" tall.

Each accommodation includes:

- Litter box
- Food & water bowls
- Towel & comfy bedding
- Shelf for sleeping or just hanging out
- Optional door to share condos if you have 2 cats

Senior cats 15 years and older require special care so all seniors board only in Geriatric.

Our Geriatric accommodations are 26.5" deep, 27.5" wide, and 25" tall.

Each accommodation includes:

- Litter box
- Food & water bowls
- Towel & comfy bedding
- Closer proximity to technicians and doctor; closely monitored

What is required prior to boarding?

Boarding is a service offered to clients of the Carnegie Cat Clinic. A doctor-client-patient relationship is important, even crucial, to our standards of care and to ensure your cat's comfort during their stay.

In the best interest of your cat(s), we require all boarders to be up-to-date on the Rabies vaccine, FVRCP (Feline Distemper) vaccine, and a fecal sample having tested negative for intestinal parasites and worms.

Prior to leaving your cat in our great hands, we'll just need 10-15 minutes to confirm some last minutes details to make your cat's stay with us as comfortable as being home!

We are also a certified Cat Friendly practice that provides 24/7 nursing care, so there is ALWAYS a technician in the building looking after, playing with, and caring for your cat.
