TOP LOCAL NEIGHBORHOODS & SURROUNDING AREAS

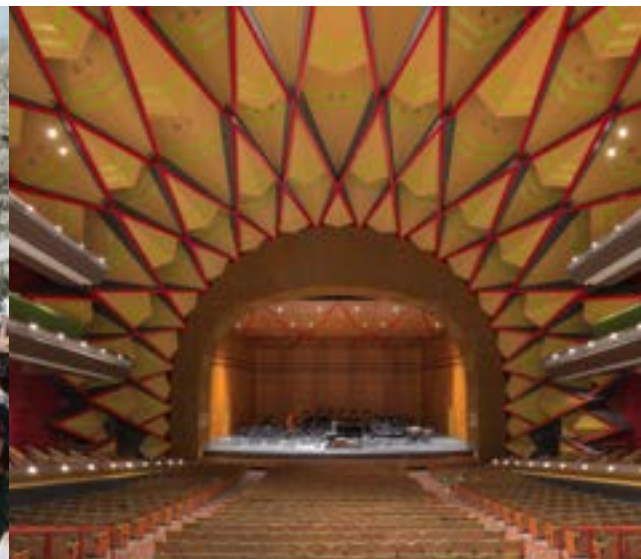
Anchorage offers diverse neighborhoods to fit a range of lifestyles.
