I understand that I assume financial responsibility for all services rendered and that payment is due at the time of discharge, unless special arrangements have been made prior to discharge. **All animals entering the hospital must be free of external parasites or they will be treated at the owner's expense.** All animals must be vaccinated, and if not, Piper Creek Vet Clinic assumes no responsibility for treatment of unvaccinated animals should they become ill. Pre-Anesthetic Blood Testing Consent Form \$105.20

Like you, our greatest concern is the wellbeing of your pet. Before putting your pet under anesthesia, we will perform a full physical examination. However, we recommend a pre-anesthesia blood profile to be performed in order that we may maximize patient safety and alert the doctor to the presence of dehydration, diabetes, kidney or liver diseases that could complicate the procedure. These tests are similar to tests that your physician would run were you to undergo anesthesia. In addition, the results of these tests may be useful later to develop faster, more accurate diagnoses and treatments in the event that your pet's health changes. State of the art equipment enables us to perform the pre-anesthetic blood profile within the clinic.
