He had intense, honest open discussions with his family and friends. He made promises to people and future plans.

For him to make the decision that he made and leave his children without a father and leave all of us he was in a distorted world of pain. So, despite our own personal grief it gives us a small amount of comfort to hope that he is peaceful.

We appreciate the support and understand that this is tragic for everyone. Please reach out if this news is triggering to you.

We are having a very small intimate family celebration of life in about a week. It's all we can manage right now as we are all just so raw. We would like to do a community event but honestly we do not have the emotional ability to do that. My apologies.

There will be a memorial spot inside the front of the clinic with a memory book. Instead of condolences our wish is for people to share a memory of Dave with us. We hope that everyone can take comfort from this because he left us with so many beautiful, quirky, funny poignant memories.
