



TYPES OF CASES WE SEE

We deal with complex medical cases and manage acute/chronic diseases. We specifically look at the internal organs and systems such as the gastrointestinal tract, liver, kidneys, endocrine system, urinary tract,

immune system, and respiratory system.

Medicine does not treat or diagnose
diseases related to the nervous system,
cardiovascular
system, or reproductive system. We create
diagnostic and/or medical management
plans for each patient that we see.

We work with the pets primary veterinarian for ongoing care but we also can help on a more urgent basis through the Emergency Department.
