Fully Funded Veterinary Clinical Trial

Canine Oral Melanoma

Before performing surgery on an oral melanoma, please contact the clinic below for study enrollment details!

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Patients will receive investigational product or placebo intravenously every 2 weeks.
- Patients will be required to visit
 Metropolitan Veterinary Hospital for regularly scheduled appointments over a 6-month time period.
- Owners will be required to document study associated observations as appropriate.

INCLUSION:

- Dog weighs >3 kg (6.6 lbs).
- Dog has been diagnosed with Stage III oral melanoma (not confined to lip). Stage III requires a historical tumor at least 4 cm longest diameter or metastatic regional lymph node.
- Surgery (no less than 14 days prior to enrollment), is acceptable provided there is at least one oral lesion with a longest diameter of ≥10 mm and/or a ≥ 15 mm (short axis) metastatic lymph node is still present.
- No prior Oncept[®] melanoma vaccine.
- No lung metastasis.

FULLY FUNDED STUDY BENEFITS:

- Study required examinations
- Lab work (CBC, blood chemistry, thyroid level, urinalysis)
- Diagnostics (thoracic radiographs)
- Investigational product (all enrolled dogs may have the option to receive the investigational product in a follow up study)
