Congratulations on your new kitten! Protection against common and often fatal diseases requires a series of vaccinations in the first few months of life with yearly boosters thereafter.

Feline Respiratory Diseases (Rhinotracheitis, Calici and Chlamydia): These diseases are highly contagious and widespread. These diseases are easily spread from cat to cat by sneezing, nose to nose contact or other forms of contact. Even a cat that appears healthy, but infected with these viruses can transmit disease to your cat. Infected cats can have cold-like symptoms that can progress to pneumonia, as well as a variety of chronic problems.

Feline Leukemia: This disease is now considered the leading cause of deaths in cats. Feline Leukemia breaks down the cat's ability to fight off infection. The cat usually dies of a disease that it would normally be able to resist. We recommend a feline leukemia test before vaccinating your kitten for this disease.

Feline Panleukopenia: Symptoms include depression, loss of appetite, fever, vomiting and diarrhea. Panleukopenia, also known as distemper, is highly contagious and can be fatal.

Intestinal Parasites: Roundworms, hookworms, whipworms, tapeworms, coccidiosis and other intestinal parasites in large numbers can cause blockage, bloody diarrhea and even death.

Rabies: Contagious viral disease transmitted by saliva of an infected animal, typically raccoons, skunks, foxes and bats.
