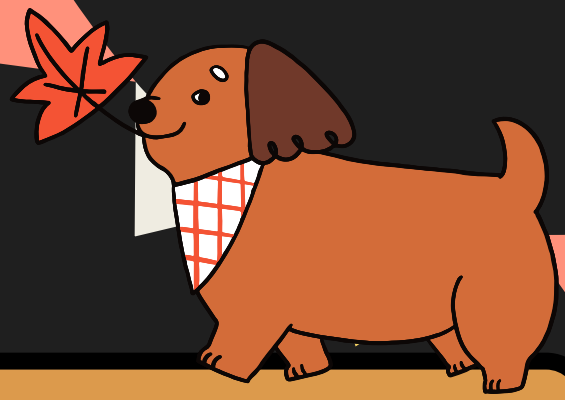

Announcing- Our new Online Patient Portal!

That's right! We now have an online patient portal where you can access your patients medical records, request refills of medication, pay your bill, and even request an appointment for your cat or dog!

Anyone can sign up for this new feature. Whether you are a new client or an existing one, you can visit our website at clovervalleyvet.com and click on the link on the upper right hand side of our website to visit the patient portal. After the page loads, just click on the " Register Account" button and fill out the required info!

If you are an existing client, don't worry! As long as 80% of your contact information matches what we have in our system, your account will automatically connect with all of the records we already have!

Once your account is made, you can access your pet's medical records at any time as long as you have internet access. This includes for emergency visits, visits when traveling with your pet, and just to check to see when they are due for their next exam and/or vaccines.
