

ORAL

teeth, and abnormal growths in the mouth

LYMPH NODES check for abnormal sized lymph nodes

gingivitis, periodontal disease, fractured




EYES

EARS visual inspection of the ear flap and outer ear canal, discharge, odors, hair in the ear canal, and inspection of the ear drum to identify any swelling in the inner ear

canal

listen for normal or abnormal cardiac sounds, listen for normal or abnormal lung sounds

HEART & LUNGS



overall nerve functioning is assessed
