- Professional Dental Cleaning and Oral Evaluation - A PAW Plan does not cover extractions or cleaning of teeth above a grade 1 level dental disease. The procedure is performed with general anesthesia, IV fluids, comprehensive monitoring and post op care. Also included: ultrasonic teeth cleaning above and below the gum line, complete oral exam, dental charting, full mouth x-rays, polish and a sealant. Full pain management injections are included. Antibiotics, special treatments if needed, and medications to go home are not included.

### Kittens

- Spay/Neuter\*\* Includes pre-anesthetic bloodwork, pain injections, IV catheter and fluids, day hospitalization and post op care, and the surgery. PAW Plans do not cover E-collars, microchips and pain meds to go home.

  \*\* Spay or Neuter must be performed before PAW Plan expires. Oral medications are not included.
