PRE-OPERATIVE BLOODWORK

Each surgical or anesthetic procedure, large or small, carries some risk. The liver or kidneys metabolize most anesthetics. We can test basic function of these organs as well as screen for diabetes, anemia, infection, and platelet-clotting function at our hospital. It only takes a few moments pre-operatively and helps us to determine if a patient has greater risks involved with the scheduled procedure.
