PAIN MANAGEMENT

Pain is a concern for us and our pets postoperatively. We believe all animals feel some degree of pain after surgery. We recommend and are able to prescribe pain medications appropriate for the procedure(s) performed.

PRE-OPERATIVE BLOODWORK

Each surgical or anesthetic procedure, large or small, carries some risk. Most anesthetics are metabolized by the liver or kidneys. We can test basic function of these organs as well as screen for diabetes, anemia, infection, and platelet (clotting) function at our hospital. It only takes a few moments pre-operatively and helps us to determine if a patient has greater risks involved with the scheduled procedure.

Presurgical screen includes :

BUN, Creatinine, ALP, AST, Total Protein, Glucose, and Complete Blood Count(CBC).
