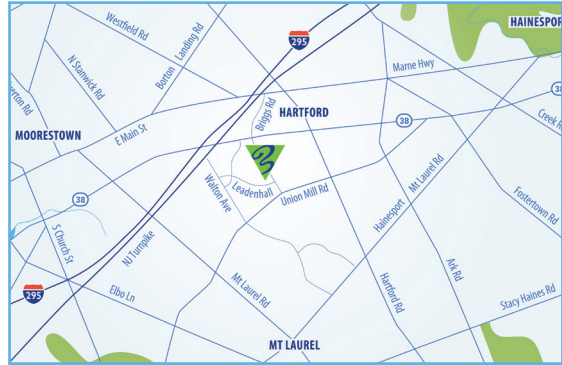
SURGERY AVAILABILITY

ORTHOPEDIC SURGERY

From the most common injuries to complicated and angular limb deformities, our surgeons have the expertise and state-of-the-art equipment to care for your pet.

Common procedures include:

- ▼ Tibial Plateau Leveling Osteotomy (TPLO)
- ▼ Patellar Luxation Correction
- ▼ Fracture Repair
- ▼ Angular Limb Deformity (ALD) Correction
- ▼ Lateral Tightrope and traditional lateral suture
- ▼ Hip toggle repair for luxation injuries
- ▼ Femoral Head Osteotomy (FHO)
- ▼ Elbow dysplasia surgeries
- ▼ Developmental joint surface surgery (Osteochondrosis)
- ▼ Musculoskeletal & joint disease

MINIMALLY INVASIVE PROCEDURES

Whenever possible, we have the ability to diagnose and operate using minimally invasive techniques. These techniques keep your pet more comfortable than some traditional approaches, and often lead to a quicker recovery with less pain.

Common minimally invasive techniques include:

- ▼ Arthroscopy for conditions involving joints (diagnosis and treatment)
- ▼ Fluoroscopy for minimally invasive fracture repair



SOFT TISSUE SURGERY

Whether your pet comes to us for treatment of cancer, reconstructive procedures following trauma, or an emergency, take comfort knowing that our surgeons are trained in every aspect of soft tissue surgery.

Common procedures include:

- ▼ Gastrointestinal Surgery
- ▼ Airway Surgery
- ▼ Thoracic Surgery
- ▼ Urogenital surgery
- ▼ Liver and Gallbladder Surgery
- ▼ Abdominal Surgery
- ▼ Head and Neck Surgery (non-neurologic)
- ▼ Hernia Repair
- ▼ Wound management
- ▼ Mass removals
