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## Enrolled Nursing Health Screening Requirements

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Please make sure you have completed all of the following requirements and have the necessary documents ready to submit.

### Medical Certificate

- Lists any health conditions that may affect your nursing practice
- Includes details of any medical treatments or management plans
- Confirms you are fit to practice — meaning your doctor believes you can safely perform all nursing and placement duties

### Immune Status Tests

- Hepatitis B (Antigen & Antibody Screen)
- Measles (Antibody Screen)
- Mumps (Antibody Screen)
- Rubella (Antibody Screen)
- Chickenpox / Varicella (Antibody Screen)
- TB (Tuberculosis) – Quantiferon TB-Gold Test (QFT-G)
- MRSA (Screening Swab)

### Important Information

- You are responsible for paying for your blood tests, vaccines, or boosters.
- If you receive a vaccine or booster, get a follow-up blood test after 30 days to check your immunity levels.
- Blood and swab tests can be done at your local Awanui Laboratory.
- Some host organisations may require extra vaccines depending on their policy.

Tip: Keep copies of all your results and certificates in one folder — you may need them again for future placements or employment.
