



LITTLE MOUSE



Play suggestion:

Place a liftable paper house on a magnetic board or whiteboard. One of the children secretly hides an animal tile under the house using blue tack while others look away. Keep all other animal tiles visible and invite children to chant:

*"Little mouse, little mouse,
Who's hiding in your house?"*

Children take turns guessing which animal is hidden.
