Play suggestion:

Invite tamariki to each take a place around the play parachute, evenly spaced. Invite tamariki to hold the play parachute and make gentle waves, big waves, and fast waves as you call out colours, numbers or movement words. You can place coloured scarves, light balls or soft toys in the centre of the play parachute and encourage children to describe what they see as colours move up, down and around.



What tamariki will learn:

- Colour recognition and descriptive language.
- Gross-motor control, rhythm, and coordination.
- Listening skills and confidence following simple instructions.
