Accessing Internet for Good through schools in BC and AB:



TELUS provides the School Board with Internet for Good redemption codes.

School Boards not already partnered with TELUS should contact their Account Executive to request redemption codes for their schools.



The School Board distributes redemption codes to schools.

Schools that have not yet received redemption codes need to request codes from their school board contact.



Schools provide redemption codes to families.

Upon identifying families in need, schools will provide them with Internet for Good redemption codes.



Families order TELUS Internet for Good.

Families who have received a redemption code from their school must call TELUS to set up their internet service.

Families are encouraged to contact their child's school to discuss their situation and inquire if the school/School Board is participating in the program.

What is TELUS Internet for Good for Students?

The TELUS Internet for Good program provides eligible low income families with low-cost internet connectivity in BC and AB (where service is available):

- Internet plans for \$9.95/month (plus applicable taxes) for 24 months; regular pricing thereafter
- Speeds of up to 25 Mbps (where available) and up to 300 GB data/month
- No contract or cancellation fees
- Option to purchase a low cost refurbished computer through BC Technology for Learning Society

In light of the unprecedented COVID-19 health crisis, school boards working with us in BC and AB can extend our Internet for Good offer directly to students and families in need, as identified by schools.

How can families sign up for TELUS Internet for Good for Students?

School Boards have been supplied with TELUS Internet for Good redemption codes to distribute to schools in their district. Schools can then provide the codes to in-need families. With a code in hand, families can call TELUS at **1-866-835-8744** to redeem the offer.

Important note: Families should discuss their situation directly with their child's school to see if the school is able to provide a code. TELUS cannot provide redemption codes directly to families for the Internet for Good for Students program.
