 401 MULTI-POINT ANTI-STREAMING SERVICE

A. GENERAL

1. Multi-point Anti-Streaming Service (MASS) provides private line data customers with the capability of isolating terminal malfunctions from the rest of the circuit.
2. The Company offers two types of Anti-Streaming: (i) Network Anti-Streaming; and (ii) Terminal Anti-Streaming.
3. MASS may be used in conjunction with the following service applications:
 - (a) Interexchange Line Mileage - Data - Item 106-A;
 - (b) Analogue Private Line Service - Data - Item 400-A; and
 - (c) Data Access System - Item 370.

1. Network Anti-Streaming: Utilizes common equipment and bridge modules located in the Company's central office; and also provides for a termination unit located at the customer's premises to interface with customer-provided equipment	\$29.95 A	\$24.00 A	\$200.00 (Notes 2&3)

C. CONDITION

Network Anti-Streaming is provided subject to the availability of suitable facilities.

- Notes:
1. The service charge for local channels specified in Items 106-A B.1.(a) iii. a), 370 B.1. and 400-A B.1.a. and b. will not apply when installed at the same time as MASS.
 2. Service charge applies per drop for new installations. A service charge, as specified in CRTC 1005, Items 106-A B.1.(a) iii) a) or 400-A B.1., applies for each on-premises move.
 3. Service Charges, as specified in Item 110 B., only apply if the customer upgrades from Terminal Anti-Streaming to Network Anti-Streaming.
